

SIRA 2009 WEIGH-IN PROCEDURES FOR COXSWAINS

To decrease the congestion and time in line for cox weigh-ins, SIRA is initiating a new policy on the procedure.

Coxswains will be responsible for their own weight. There will be a small supply of plastic bags and sand available at weigh-in, but each cox, especially if he/she is well below the limit, should bring weights to the scales to be as close as possible to the correct weight.

Those who do not make weight will be allowed to adjust what they are carrying, but NOT while on line. The adjustment can be made at a station nearby and then the cox will return to the end of the line.
